





Virtual Pendle 3km Pedal: Sat 27th June – Sun 12th July inc

FAQ's

- What is the Virtual Pendle 3km Pedal? It's an opportunity for families and / or individuals to organise their own bike ride within the dates above and earn points for their school. There is also a photo competition see below.
- Can I / my group do more than 3km? The minimum distance for the event is 3km however feel free to go further than this. Regardless of how far you go, your nominated school will score 1 point per person. Please ensure you complete the event form listing the date of your ride.
- Can I use the same email address to enter more than one child?

 Yes, you can use the same email address to enter as many children or relations as you like (e.g. schools that are doing this with their key worker pupils). Note, you will need to add each child / person individually.
- Can non-pupils nominate a school? Yes if you are associated with a school in anyway (e.g. former pupil, teacher, school staff, parent, grandparent, relative etc) you can put down that school.
- How do I evidence our bike ride?

 There's no need to send in Strava details etc. Simply list the date of your ride on the entry form once completed, however it would be super if you could upload a picture / video to our facebook page of you and your family on the ride. Even better, if you could get a shot of your group with a local Pendle landmark. There will be a prize for best photo / video.

- I just want to have a go; do I need to complete the event form?

 Yes please because the school with the most participants entered will be crowned Champions. We can also issue certificates afterwards by using your email address on the event form. Your school will record 1 point for every entry. Wider family can also score a point for a nominated school by taking part. Any staff from schools will earn 2 points.
- **Do you have to be from Pendle to enter?** Whilst we are encouraging residents of Pendle to take part, we are happy to take entries from further afield. However, if they are associated with a school outside of







the borough of Pendle, that school won't be part of our school's competition.

- When is the closing date? The cycle event and photo competition will close at midnight on Sunday 12th July so please log your ride before then.
- **Is there any recognition for my achievement?** Yes everyone who enters will receive a certificate. There will be a scoreboard where every school will receive a point for every participant registered under that school's name. Which school will be the overall Pendle winner?
- I'm not sure of where to cycle? There is the Steven Burke Hub in Barrowford which is traffic free and perfect for beginners. Each lap is approx. 1km. The Leeds and Liverpool canal is also a good option. There are a number of suggested routes on our Facebook page also or www.Pendlessp.com
- I'd like to have a go but I don't have a bike? There is a community day to enable non bike owners to get involved, on Saturday 11th July (10am 3pm) at the Steven Burke track in Barrowford. Adult and child bikes and helmets are available to hire for free for 30 mins. Please use this link to book your slot listing how many family members are coming along.
